

CURBSIDE ZERO-SORT RECYCLING

The first week of recycling was a great success, more than 6 tons of recycling material was collected. Thanks to everyone who participated.

A few reminders...

- Using large barrels for recyclables is great since we are on a biweekly schedule. However, if the barrel is too heavy the collector cannot lift it to empty in the truck.
 - If you have a barrel (Toter) that has the small lip in the front by the lid, and the bar across the front, you can fill this up as much as you want, the truck has an automatic arm that can lift these.
 - If you have a regular trash barrel or a barrel on wheels that does not have the bar in the front, please do not fill over 50 lbs. If your recycling exceeds that limit, please use more than one barrel.
- All containers must be at the end of your driveway or road by 7:00 am
- Please, no plastic bags in the recycling containers, plastic bags can be recycled at the grocery store.
- If you have small items such as shredded paper that you want to put in a bag for recycling, please use a paper bag.
- Containers must be clearly marked as to what is recycling. Some residents are using barrels that are premarket with recycling information, but they are being used for trash. Please stick something on the barrel to note that it is trash.



If you have multiple cans for trash and recycling and a driveway that is wide enough, you may consider putting trash containers on one side of the driveway and recycling containers on the other side. This will help the collectors identify which barrel is trash and which is for recycling.
