

AN ORDINANCE
VOTED BY THE SELECTMEN
TOWN OF NORTHFIELD

NEW HAMPSHIRE

DATE: May 17, 1977

RELATIVE TO: CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC PLACES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF NORTHFIELD

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO CONSUME ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR LIQUOR AS DEFINED IN CHAPTER 175 OF THE NEW HAMPSHIRE REVISED STATUTES ANNOTATED, UPON ANY PUBLIC STREET, PUBLIC HIGHWAY, PUBLIC SIDEWALK, PUBLIC OR MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT, MUNICIPAL PARK OR ANY OTHER PROPERTY OWNED BY THE PUBLIC WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF NORTHFIELD, NEW HAMPSHIRE. THE SELECTMEN MAY ISSUE AT THEIR DISCRETION A WRITTEN PERMIT AS AN EXCEPTION TO THIS ORDINANCE FOR SPECIFIC SPECIAL EVENTS.

PENALTY: ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THE ABOVE ORDINANCE SHALL BE GUILTY OF A VIOLATION AS DEFINED IN CHAPTER 625: SECTION 9 OF THE NEW HAMPSHIRE REVISED STATUTES ANNOTATED - TITLE LXII.

NOTICE: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON SIGNING BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN
