

AN ORDINANCE
VOTED BY THE SELECTMEN
TOWN OF NORTHFIELD
NEW HAMPSHIRE

DATE: NOVEMBER 8, 1977

RELATIVE TO: STOP SIGN AT INTERSECTION OF NEW BRIDGE AT ELM STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF NORTHFIELD:

IN ACCORDANCE WITH AUTHORITY GRANTED IN NEW HAMPSHIRE REVISED STATUTES
CHAPTER 41, SECTION 11.

A STANDARD STOP SIGN IS HEREBY ORDERED ERECTED AND MAINTAINED AT THE
INTERSECTION OF THE NEW BRIDGE AND ELM STREET, EFFECTING SOUTHBOUND
TRAFFIC EXITING FROM SAID BRIDGE.

ALL TRAFFIC APPROACHING THE ABOVE NAMED STOP SIGN AT THE SAID INTER-
SECTION SHALL FIRST COME TO A FULL STOP; EXCEPT WHEN DIRECTED OTHERWISE
BY A POLICE OR TRAFFIC OFFICER OR OTHER LAWFUL TRAFFIC REGULATION SIGN,
DEVICE, OR SIGNAL AND SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT OF WAY TO ALL OTHER VEHICLES
BEFORE PROCEEDING.

NOTICE: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PROPER
POSTING OF THE SAID STOP SIGN AND PROPER NOTICE IN A NEWSPAPER.
