Minutes: Dave Krause moved, seconded by Sterling Blackey to accept the minutes of Feb. 25, 2015 as read. Motion passed.

Abutter letter: Members reviewed a letter to an abutter of land on Oak Hill Road and agreed to send it as presented.

- As we haven't had much luck getting official maps made for Doubleday and Sotir trails, Dave and Sterling will work on tracking the trails by gps and putting the information on current maps. The additional trails on the Knowles Pond property need to be added to the existing map.
- Sterling Blackey has materials for the Sotir and Doubleday kiosks.
- When maps are complete they will be placed on the large kiosk at the parking lot and then plexi glass can be installed.
- Cleanup will be scheduled next month

Correspondence:

- Big Trees of NH – Kevin Fife moved, seconded by Sterling Blackey to purchase a copy of Big Trees of NH for \$24.95 and donate the book to Hall Memorial Library. Motion passed.

- Saving Special Places – Dave Krause moved, seconded by Sterling Blackey to reimburse fees for any member wishing to attend this conference on April 11, 2015 for \$60 each. Motion passed.

Other:

The Corliss family is working with Five Rivers Conservation Trust relative to a potential conservation easement on the Corliss Farm. The Conservation Commission members definitely support the concept and wish to help enable the easement to happen, but funds are limited. Methods of matching "in kind" by placing an easement on other property were discussed but further information is needed.
