Mr. Blackey suggested advertising on the Town website places where residents can snowshoe and hike.

4. **Other Business:** Ms. Cole provided some information about the Moose Plate Grant and the Conservation Committee Grant that was requested by Christina Beadle to see if any of the projects that the Commission has lined up would be eligible for the grants.

Mr. Page asked besides water quality testing did the Commission have any other projects on the horizon. Chairman Fife mentioned possibly seeing about purchasing property that was historic and rebuilding it back up.

Chairman Fife mentioned he had been talking to the loggers in the area, and that they are frustrated due to all the mud. Mr. Blackey agreed it is easier for logging in the winter due to the ground being frozen.
