

Town of Northfield Police Officers

The Northfield Police Department is now currently seeking a Police Officer to fill a Full-Time position. Applications will be accepted at any time with no closing date for submission.

Applicants must be at least 21 years of age, possess a valid driver's license, be a US Citizen, and be able to pass an extensive background investigation to include polygraph examination, psychological evaluation, and successfully pass a physical agility test. A high school diploma or equivalent is required, and post-secondary education is preferred, with a focus on criminal justice or a related field. Applicants must also either possess a full time police certification from NH, or another state, provided that they can successfully obtain a NH certification based on their prior experience after being hired, or be able to complete the Certification program with the NH Police Academy.

The Town of Northfield offers a competitive pay and benefits package as well as a generous sign on bonus for certified officers. Benefits include 11 paid holidays, paid time off, short and long term disability coverage, life insurance, medical and dental insurance, and a sign-on bonus for certified officers at \$5,000, and non-certified officers at \$2,500. The Town of Northfield also offers an insurance buyout program of up to **\$10,000.00 per year**, if you have other options for medical insurance coverage.

Salary for certified officers is determined based on prior law enforcement experience. Responsibilities include standard patrol functions, traffic control and enforcement. Additional opportunities available include criminal investigations, bike patrol, SWAT and community relations.
