The month of April was an up and down weather month. We had two decent size snow storms that brought trees and wires down. We spent about a week cleaning up the trees that came down around town. The roads that had to be closed were back open within a couple of days after the storm.

We pulled the posting on all roads by April 12th. Spent some time cleaning up the Town Hall and cemeteries getting ready for the mowing season. Finally started grading dirt roads and worked on Silver Lane adding some gravel.

We held interviews which we had two good candidates hired out of those interviews. One has started and one will be starting next week.

We had a great Q&A for road bids and R&D was the awarded bidder to reclaim and pave selected roads for this summer. We have jumped on the work we need to do to get ready for these projects. Our main focus right now is to complete Blueberry first. With the reclaim and adding gravel we will be assessing ditching the roads after they lay down the base coat. I also met with CWS guardrail and received a quote to do most of the guardrail around town.

We have been also getting the trucks switched from winter to summer. Taking off plow frames and doing services that are needed before we get into summer mode.
