We started the month off with some snow on Sunday the 3rd going into Monday the 4th which we plowed and treated, and have been out a few times to treat for black ice or refreeze.

We took advantage of the nice weather and worked on tree trimming and cleaning of drainage.

Then we had a couple of rain events which one caused a bit of damage around town. Shaker Road was closed for one day due to a tree down on wires. There were washouts in a lot of areas throughout town such as Bean Hill Rd (gravel), Shaker Rd (gravel) both requiring 3 loads of stone, Haggett Farm and Rand Rd (gravel) all took a hit from the rain. Rain has not stopped, but we are making progress with the washouts and continue to respond as fast as we can.

Sara Ln, Silver Ln, and Megan Dr are complete for the drainage project. R&D reclaimed the road as approved.

I will be working with Jared Hebert on road construction, setting estimated pricing and priorities to report to the CIP Committee.
