Skate Bench	\$ 1,100


Total Value (to be completed) : \$30,600

By supporting a *community skate park* we are not only showing the kids that we care about their safety, but that we also care about their interests.




DAVID KING TRYON MEMORIAL SKATE PARK

The David King Tryon Memorial Skate Park Committee is a volunteer organization responsible for the construction of a basic skate board park located in Northfield, NH for recreational use for Tilton and Northfield area youth.

The project is estimated at \$58,000. Through youth fund raising, community outreach and in-kind donations we are within \$36,600 of accomplishing this goal.



Who is building the park?

Project TNS is a non-profit for youth organization which is raising funding for construction of the Park through fundraising and grants.

Who will manage the park?

The Town of Northfield will own and operate the Park. The Town's insurance covers the Skate Park under its current policy with no additional costs for the Skate Park.

There is no maintenance to the equipment. The equipment made of powder coated steel and concrete.
