

**NORTHFIELD CONSERVATION COMMISSION**  
**JULY 21, 2010**  
**MINUTES**

Members present: Rich Bellerose, Diane Moreau and Cathy Thibeault.

**Robert Murdoch:** Mr. Murdock presented several photos of the erosion occurring on his waterfront at Sandogardy Pond. Approximately 35' of his 50' frontage has been impacted, making it difficult to access his boat. He plans to submit a Standard Dredge and Fill application and will complete the work according to DES' approval. He is thinking that rocks should be installed to avoid further erosion and a set of steps for him to get to the water. Members had no issues with the proposal as long as Mr. Murdock complies with DES' requirements. Once the application has been submitted, the Commission may want to visit the site in order to send comments to DES.

**Minutes:** Diane Moreau moved, seconded by Cathy Thibeault to accept the minutes of June 23, 2010 as read. Motion passed.

**Shaker Road ramp:** The ramp is partially complete at this time and now is being used quite heavily. NH Lakes Association is willing to supply a "ramp volunteer" who talks with users of the ramp educating them about milfoil issues next year. This will involve either monetary or volunteer matching by the town.

**WRTA:** The secretary updated the Commission on the status of the trail to date.

**Land purchase:** As there has been no response to the Commission's offer to purchase, a new letter will be sent re-affirming interest in the parcel.

**Other:**

- \$12 from sale of hat and t-shirts to be put into the Conservation Fund.
- PSNH – conducting a walkabout on the power lines
- UMLAC – canoe trip August 14
- Fencing for Granite Street – Cathy Thibeault moved, seconded by Diane Moreau to spend up to \$500 for fencing from the 2010 budget. Motion passed.

Meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm in order to visit the Granite Street site and measure for fencing.
