Although the septic leaching fields appear to be adequate, members questioned whether a septic design will be required for a septic tank specifically for the bunkhouse.

Update on River Trail: Ernie's has been purchased by the Town of Tilton and engineering studies will begin this summer to determine the best location for the pedestrian bridge.

Land Donation: Mr. King would like to donate his land on Bean Hill to the Conservation Commission. He will contact us later in the spring to discuss this transaction.
