Public Input

Andrea White asked the Board about putting a street light at the intersection of Caveney Drive and Bay St. Her concern is that when children are waiting for the bus at that intersection, vehicles turning onto Caveney Drive cannot see the kids because it is so dark. Board members agreed to look into that intersection and see if they can move a light from another pole to put on the pole closest to the intersection.

White inquired about the drainage on Caveney Drive as she noticed that the catch basin across the street from her house empties into her yard. Board members asked Stephanie Giovannucci to look into any easements the Town may have for drainage.

Public Works Department

Andy Buteau informed the Board that he will need to post the roads soon and needed confirmation as to who owned Sandogardy Pond Road. Sel. Crowley stated that the Town owns the road, per the contract which states upon initiation of construction the town owns the road.

Police Department

Sel. Crowley asked the Chief Raffaely about parking on Elm Street. Chief Raffaely stated there is a problem at one residence in particular. The Board asked Stephanie Giovannucci to reach out to the owner of the property and ask them to come to the next meeting.

Administration

Board members reviewed the Warrant articles and who would speak to each article. Stephanie Giovannucci informed the Board of the change in meeting days for the Conservation Commission.

Crowley/Haskins moved to approve the meeting minutes of February 26, 2019. **Motion Passed.**
