

**NORTHFIELD BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING**  
**Minutes of the Meeting of August 28, 2018**

The meeting was called to order at 5:18pm

Selectmen discussed Island Park maintenance issues with Tilton Selectmen and agreed that work should be shared more equally. Jon Scanlon asked if trees could be cut to provide for a better view of the Arch from downtown Tilton. It was noted that many of these are not on town property. Sel.
