

AN ORDINANCE  
VOTED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
TOWN OF NORTHFIELD, N. H.

February 24, 1981

RELATIVE TO: Abandoned, condemned, and fire-gutted buildings.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Northfield as follows:

SECTION I - It shall be unlawful for any building to remain standing after a major fire, unless rebuilding of said structure is in process within twelve (12) calendar months of said fire. Otherwise, said building shall be torn down and cellar hole filled, within twelve (12) calendar months of fire.

SECTION II - It shall be unlawful for any building to remain standing unsecured by any entry thereto, or which has been condemned by health officials. Such structure shall be made completely safe or destroyed within one (1) year (12 calendar months) from condemning.

PENALTY - Any violation of Section I and II shall be a violation which could result in a daily fine, not more than \$100.00 per day and not less than \$50.00 per day, based on twelve (12) calendar months of order.
