

NORTHFIELD BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
Minutes of the Meeting of Tuesday November 13, 2018

Present: Sel. Crowley, Sel. Haskins

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm

1. Public Input

The Chair recognized Mr. and Mrs. Landau who outlined that situation with the well on their property. The system serves 5 homes, Mr. Landau bills people for the use of the system to cover electrical costs. Board members reviewed system shut off options with Mr. and Mrs. Landau.

The Chair recognized Mr. Staller who reviewed the work that Child and Family Services conducts statewide and in Northfield. Board members inquired as to the size of the organization's endowment, sourced of grant income and services provided by the organization. After discussion, Board members indicated they support Child and Family Services' 2019 budget request.

2. Public Works Department

Sel. Crowley indicated he would like to host a public hearing on the decision to cease plowing parking lots in Surrette, Arch and Glines parks. Glenn was asked to schedule this for December 4th.

3. Police Department

Board members discussed the budget schedule. Sel. Crowley asked Glenn to forward Public Works budget forms to him. Chief Raffaely updated the Board on weekend activity. Also he reported that over the weekend the sump pump at the PD failed and he replaced it.

4. Administration

Board members reviewed the budget requests of the Tilton-Northfield Recreation Council, Hall Memorial Library, Youth Assistance Program and the Park Cemetery Association. Glenn was asked to invite representatives of the Tilton-Northfield Recreation Council and Hall Memorial Library in for a follow-up information session. The budget requests of the Youth Assistance Program and the Park Cemetery Association were approved.

Sel. Crowley provided an update of the Sandogardy Pond Road project.

Sel. Crowley asked that overtime rates and 2019 medical insurance costs be added to the next agenda.

Sel. Crowley noted that the next meeting should start at 4:30 as the CIP committee has scheduled

a meeting for 7:00pm the same evening.

5. General Business

Crowley/Haskins moved to approve the minutes of the meeting of October 30, 2018. **Motion passed.** Board members reviewed general correspondence, payroll and accounts payable manifests.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 pm.
