Minutes: Kevin Fife moved, seconded Dave Krause to accept the minutes of May 22, 2013 as read. Motion passed.

The Commission will ask Bill Dawson to schedule a “Speaking for Wildlife Walk” at the Knowles Pond Conservation area in the fall.

PB & ZBA applications:

- Freudenberg – no further comment
- Vary – no comment

Trail Maintenance updates:

- Smart Cons. Area – there are two trees across the trail that need to be cut by chain saw. Very little litter and no tent sites on the trail.
- Knowles Pond Cons. Area – a three sided “log” structure has been created near the water’s edge with some litter left behind.
- Sotir – additional conservation easement signs are needed along the road. It would be good to make a loop trail connecting with the existing trails.
- Doubleday – New conservation easement signs have been placed on the boundary. The existing trail currently wanders off the easement property which places unnecessary liability on the Doubledays. Since there is plenty of room to have the trail entirely on the easement area, the trail will be relocated.
